RIDING CLUB TEAM SHOW JUMPING CHALLENGE.



This show jumping challenge is a competition with 10-12 show jumps. The optimum time is based on a speed of 375m/minute.

	Maximum Height 1 st round	Maximum height 2 nd round
2 riders	70cm	75cm
2 riders	80cm	85cm
Jump off	One member of the team to be selected by team	Jump off 90cm

This competition is run under BRC rules. Each Team Manager is responsible for ensuring that all team members are conversant with these and the following.

1. No horse or rider may compete in more than one challenge competition at Burgham International Horse Trials
2. Horse/rider combinations must not have competed at either CIC2*, CC12* or higher in the 2019/2020 season
3. A team consists of four riders with the best three scores to count, mixed teams are allowed.
4. All hats must be tagged with a current coloured tag.
5. No jewellery, watches or stopwatches allowed. No electronic recording devices are permitted on horse or rider.
6. All hair must not be below shoulder length, and if so, be put into in a hair net.
7. Dress will be jacket, and light coloured breeches.
8. Each horse will be provided with two wrist bands for entrance into show ground.
9. All horses must be five years of age and over and must be vaccinated against equine influenza. Passports must be available on request and spot checks may be carried out. Vaccinations must be in accordance with BRC rules 2020 rule book.
10. If a rider falls from their horse, they must be seen by designated medical staff before continuing.
11. The judge's decision is final. They may disqualify any rider at any stage in the competition for dangerous riding, inappropriate behaviour or language, abuse of officials, misuse of whip or spurs. Ill treatment of the horse or if in their opinion the horse is lame, sick or unfit to compete.
12. Each competitor must be a member of an affiliated British Riding Club.
- 13 Prize giving will be at the end of the each section, this will be mounted for the winning team and unmounted for teams 2nd to 6th.
14. The organising committee of Burgham International Horse Trials reserve the right to make any changes/amendments to the competition.
